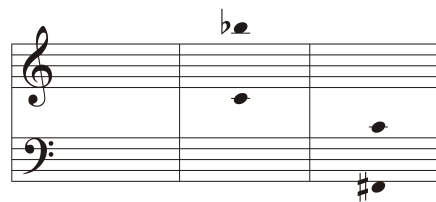

## **Like to audition for the chorus, but don't know how to prepare?**

We like to encourage all levels of singers to join our chorus so the brief audition is not so much to rate your singing as it is to ensure that you are not tone deaf!

Take a look at these general notes! ....

Your choral audition will be very short, non-threatening and will consist of one song selection and a brief assessment of vocal range.

**Chorus:** Those auditioning for chorus may sing anything they wish. "My Country 'Tis of Thee" is the default choice. You can be as plain or as fancy as you like, from any style of repertoire you like, but remember, brevity is a virtue! Two minutes or less, please. Choose something you know without thinking about it, just so we can hear the general quality of your voice. If you plan on singing something other than the default piece above then please bring sheet music in the correct key.

**Vocal Range:** It will save time if you already know your highest and lowest reliable note, so that you can jot them on the audition sheet. If you don't know, we'll find them during the audition.
